Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Quacco Road Phase II Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Pooler. Funding will be used to continue vital improvements needed for Quacco Road. Continued progress on this vital corridor is essential, not only for the City of Pooler, but for the broader countywide area as well. This project includes improvements from the intersection of Pooler Parkway and Blue Moon Crossing through the intersection of Quacco Road and Canal Bank Road. Quacco Road is a major corridor that has seen tremendous commercial and residential growth. Traffic volumes have increased at a rate above the average of other areas within the community. The project includes widening the two-lane sections of the roadway to 4 lanes, drainage improvements and intersection improvements along the corridor for safety. Two new traffic signals, the modification of two additional signalized intersections and a roundabout are included in the project.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133 Surface Transportation Block Grant Program.
