3 Section 1403(d) of the Victims of Crime Act of 1984 4 (34 U.S.C. 20102) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (3), by striking "and domestic 5 violence" and inserting "domestic violence, and illicit 6 7 fentanyl poisoning resulting in death"; and

8 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking "and" at the 9 end;

(3) in paragraph (5), by striking the period and 10 11 inserting "; and"; and

(4) by adding at the end the following:

"(6) the term 'illicit fentanyl' means fentanyl 13 14 and any analogue thereof that is manufactured, distributed, or dispensed, or possessed with intent to 15 16 manufacture, distribute, or dispense, in violation of 17 section 401, 406, or 416 of the Controlled Sub-18 stances Act.".
