1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Undersea Cable Pro-3 tection Act of 2025".

4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON REQUIRING AUTHORIZATIONS
5 FOR UNDERSEA FIBER OPTIC CABLES PRE6 VIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL OR
7 STATE AGENCIES.

8 The National Marine Sanctuaries Act (16 U.S.C.
9 1431 et seq.) is amended by inserting after section 310
10 the following:

11 "SEC. 310A. PROHIBITION ON REQUIRING AUTHORIZA12 TIONS FOR UNDERSEA FIBER OPTIC CABLES
13 PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL OR
14 STATE AGENCIES.

15 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-16 vision of this Act, the Secretary may not prohibit or re-17 quire any authorization for the installation, continued presence, operation, maintenance, repair, or recovery of 18 19 undersea fiber optic cables in a national marine sanctuary if a license, lease, or permit has been issued by a Federal 2021 or State agency authorizing such installation, continued 22 presence, operation, maintenance, repair, or recovery.

"(b) INTERAGENCY COOPERATION.—The Secretary
may direct the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to engage in interagency cooperation under section 304(d) in any Federal agency action described in that

- 1 section and involving the installation, continued presence,
- 2 operation, maintenance, repair, or recovery of undersea
- 3 fiber optic cables in a national marine sanctuary.".
